## STATEMENT


### Is SPECK PUMPEN conform to REACH?


SPECK PUMPS has a quality management system according to DIN EN ISO 9001:2000. In line with this management system, legal and general claims have to be controlled and supervised. The claims of REACH (Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals) are a part of it.

Collaborating with TÜV Rheinland we effected an analysis and reached the following conclusion:

Our pumps and spare parts pass through machining and working operations and are being assembled at our company. We neither produce nor sell goods as per the REACH regulation. According to the REACH regulation our products are "manufactured items". In collaboration with our suppliers we have started to check our products for substances of very high concern in order to notify them at the ECHA (European Agency for Chemicals) by the month of June in 2011 if necessary.

Consequently a pre-registration and registration according to the REACH regulation is **absolutely not** relevant for products (manufactured) by SPECK PUMPEN.

  
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
